Get Ready to Complete the FAFSA!

Set aside about 30 to 45 minutes to complete the application.

Simplify the process by having certain information ready. Here's what to gather or know ahead:

- Your Social Security number.
- Tax records – you may be able to import some tax data using the IRS data retrieval tool on the FAFSA site. The FAFSA will tell you what year's taxes to use.
- Your Federal Student Aid Identification Number (FSA ID), which is needed to sign the application electronically.
- Parental information including tax records and FSA ID (if the FAFSA determines you are a dependent student).
- Names of schools you're interested in attending. The FAFSA data will be sent to these schools.
