
The Student Success Puzzle Challenge!

Puzzle Challenge Tips


- > The side with the artwork may not be the starting point. Like students, each box is unique.
- ▶ When the middle piece in 'step 2' is partially pulled out, it should be facing you. You may have to flip or turn the puzzle to accommodate.
- ▷ Keep track of the puzzle pieces as you remove them from the box...this will help you know the sequence for reassembling the puzzle.
- You may have to slightly shift pieces inside the box to get other pieces to slide out (e.g., step 4).
- Donce all pieces are removed, then you can reassemble the puzzle by reversing the steps.

Puzzle Assembly Steps
















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
